Berrinba Wetlands is a 120ha precinct in Browns Plains showcasing environmental and industrial best practice.

Once a degraded sand mining site, Logan City Council's commitment to rehabilitate the area has resulted in parklands with plenty of open space for recreation.

Approximately 80ha of the site has been protected and enhanced so that local residents can enjoy the natural beauty and wildlife of the wetlands environment.

Community facilities include an Interpretive Centre, boardwalks and walking trails as well as a kiosk, BBQs, covered picnic areas and public toilets.
